



FESTIVAL CONDITIONS 2011

"Event" means T in the Park Festival. **"Management"** means DF Concerts Limited, company registration number SC333566. **"Promoter"** means the person or company staging the Event if different from the Management. **"Terms and Conditions"** means these terms and conditions. **"Venue"** means Balado, Kinross-Shire, Scotland. **"Ticket"** means any ticket for You to attend an Event. **"You"** means you as the holder of the Ticket and **"Your"** shall be read accordingly.

1. These Festival Conditions, in addition to the Event Terms and Conditions, apply to any person who holds a Ticket for the Event.
2. You must retain your Ticket at all times. Tickets and wristbands (if applicable) will not be replaced under any circumstances.
3. Each Camper will receive the appropriate number of wristbands on entry, which must not be removed until departure. Failure to show an intact wristband on request by stewards will lead to entry to the camping area being refused and could result in You being asked to leave the Event.
4. Camping is only permitted in the designated areas. Campers must pitch their tent responsibly and sensibly, without blocking pathways or fire lanes.
5. You may be searched before entering the Event. If illegal substances are found, you may be prosecuted. Management, at its discretion, may confiscate any item that is deemed illegal or unsuitable. This includes illegal or intoxicating substances, fireworks including any flame, smoke or gas device, smoke canisters, portable laser equipment, air horns, spray cans any item that can be considered a weapon. Any person in possession of such articles may be refused entry or ejected.
6. Campfires are strictly forbidden.
7. Loud music systems, gazebos, canvas tents and candles are not permitted.
8. No folding chairs or inflatable chairs are permitted in the arena and cannot be taken from the campsite to the arena.
9. Each Camper may bring food and drinks to the campsite for his/her own consumption, provided they are not in glass bottles. Food and drink will be available for purchase at the Event. Excessive amounts of food, cigarettes and/or alcohol may be confiscated. Glass bottles or containers (including cosmetics) are not permitted. All glass will be confiscated and not returned.
10. It is not permitted to bring food and drink into the arena or from the campsite to the arena with the exception of unopened or empty plastic water bottles for filling up at the water points.
11. Gas cylinders and camping stoves are not permitted for safety reasons. Anyone found in possession of an unauthorised gas cylinder or camping stove may be asked to leave. Small disposable BBQs will be permitted for use in the campsite fire lanes only, however the Management reserves the right to confiscate these if used irresponsibly.
12. With the exception of special assistance dogs, no animals are permitted at the Venue.
13. The Management does not accept responsibility for loss of property or damage to persons or property. Campers must not leave valuables in the camping areas – campers should keep valuables on their person at all times or use the locker facilities provided (please book in advance).
14. No trading without the consent of the Management. Anyone found doing so will have their goods confiscated and they will be removed from the Venue.
15. If a Camper intends to camp in a campervan he/she must have purchased a campervan ticket in advance for access to a pitch of 7m x 7m. If more space is required for the vehicle a second ticket must be purchased. No caravans, vans or cars will be allowed in the campervan area. Only one LPG gas cylinder is permitted per campervan. Petrol generators will not be permitted. Number of passengers must not exceed campervan sleeping capacity.
16. Please refer to www.tinthepark.com/travel for the Car Park Rules if you are travelling to the Event by car. It is your responsibility to check this prior to attending the festival and ensure you comply.
17. No Children Under 5. Children under 16 must be accompanied by a guardian over 21.
18. Failure to follow any of the Festival Conditions and/or Terms and Conditions or behaving in a manner deemed unsociable or potentially dangerous will result in You being ejected from the Event without refund. The Management may prosecute anyone found to be breaking the law.
19. Management reserve the right to refuse admission. Any individual who has previously been ejected from the site should not purchase a ticket as they will be refused entry to the event
